Deadline is March 23, 2023. Register ASAP as space is limited to 24 young people from across the State. LEGISLATIVE NOTES

House Republicans passed the Pandemic is Over Act (HR 382), to immediately end the national emergency; the bill is now in the Senate. The Biden administration has declared that national emergency pandemic measures will end May 11. The Department of Veterans Affairs is asking to keep the authority to conduct telehealth appointments and prescribe medications across state lines. COVID rules allowed physicians to hold virtual appointments with patients and approve medications, including controlled substances. This has bolstered the VA's ability to provide care to veterans in rural or remote areas. -- Military.com South Dakota's 98th Legislative Session had 450 bills and 41 resolutions for action. SB 13 and SB 14, a pair of bills related to the BG Dean Mann Readiness Center in Sioux Falls, have been sent to the Governor for signature, as has SB 15, to accept Uniformed Services ID as proof for adding veteran designation to state license or ID card. The House Committee on Appropriations has passed HB 1039 to increase tuition payments for National Guard members from 50% to 100%, HR 1045 to increase basic salaries for county veterans' service officers, and HB 1065 to increase state payment from \$100 to \$200 to erect headstones for deceased veterans.
