LEGISLATIVE NOTES Diane Diekman

House Democrats are jumping ship on the traditionally bipartisan defense authorization bill after Republicans passed amendments to the fiscal 2024 National Defense Authorization Act to overturn the Pentagon's new abortion travel policy and to restrict transgender medical care. Democrats who usually support the defense bill announced they would now vote against final passage. Should the House pass defense legislation overturning those policies, it will run into opposition from the Democratic-held Senate and the White House. The House Rules Committee has put 370 amendments to the bill on the floor. -- Defense News

President Joe Biden nominated Admiral Lisa Franchetti as the next Chief of Naval Operations, which would make her the first woman ever to serve on the Joint Chiefs of Staff. With 38 years in the military, she currently serves as Vice Chief of Naval Operations and is only the second woman to be a four-star admiral. She joins more than 250 other senior military officers whose confirmations over the last four months have been stalled by Senator Tommy Tuberville, R-Ala., over the Defense Department's abortion policies. Under rules put in place last fall, troops stationed in states where abortion is limited or illegal can be granted leave time and travel stipends to help cover the cost of moving across state lines for abortion services. Tuberville and a host of Republican lawmakers have decried the policy as illegal. There is no resolution in sight. The Senate is on its late-summer recess and will return in September. -- Defense News


